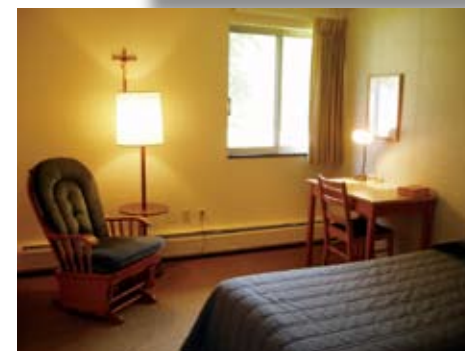

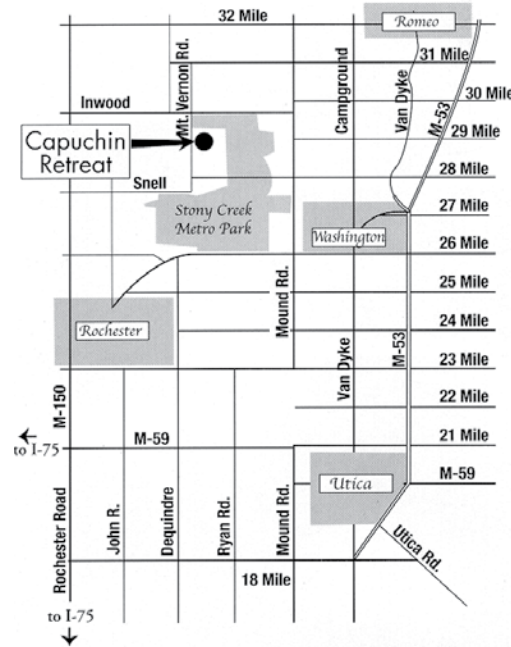


The Lounge

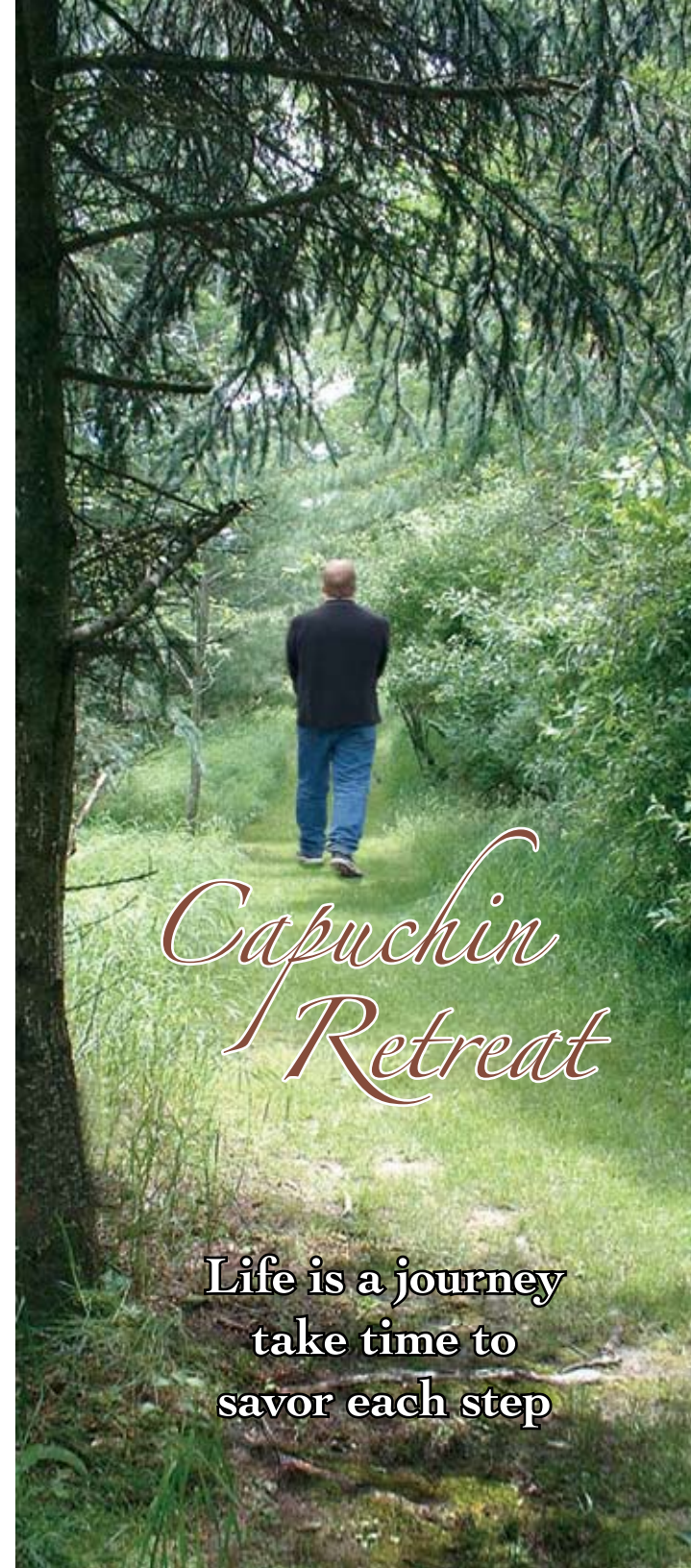
