



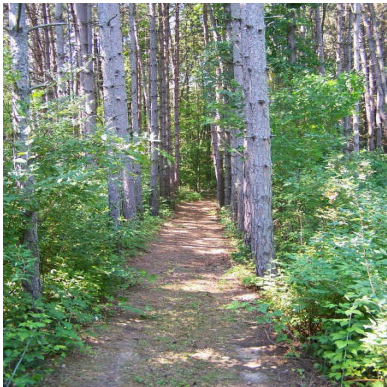
Facilitator:
